

Getting to Sugar Loaf Monday 1st May 2017

Sat nav (nearest post code): NP7 7LA



Information

Please make sure you can get to the car park at Sugar Loaf for 9.00am on Monday 1st May and our final walk will begin shortly after. There is ample parking here, but it does tend to get busy so please ensure you allow yourself enough time to travel and prepare once you've arrived.

Please find below some helpful instructions about getting to Sugar Loaf from the M4 and the map overleaf which cross-references.

Directions

Get on to the M4 Westbound towards South Wales and stay on the M4 until junction 24 (Celtic Manor/ Newport junction) and take the **A449** exit to A48 East

At the roundabout take the 4th exit onto the **A449**

Stay on the **A449** and follow signs for Abergavenny/ Y Fenni

After around 13 miles, use the left lane to take the **A40** slip road to Abergavenny/Y Fenni and continue on the **A40**

After 1 mile and on reaching the roundabout, take the 3rd exit and stay on **A40**

1) At Hardwick Gyratory, take the 2nd exit onto Heads of the Valleys Rd/ **A465**

2) After around another 0.5 miles take the **A4143/ B4246** exit towards Abergavenny/Y Fenni

3) Stay on Merthyr Road (**A4143**), continue straight on and follow signs to get back on the **A40** towards Brecon

4) At the roundabout where 'Nevil Hall Hospital' is signposted, take the first exit and return back onto the **A40** (the Town Centre will be signposted to your right)

5) Continue on the **A40** Brecon Road (past Nevil Hall Hospital which will be on your left) and continue for around 1 mile until you see signposts for 'Sugar Loaf Vineyard'. The entrance for this road (Pentre Road) is quite concealed and is a fairly narrow lane next to a cottage. If you've reached the Lamb & Flag pub then you've gone too far!

6) Continue up the track on Pentre Road with the housing estate on your right. When you reach the next junction, take a left where the stone cottage is in front of you and continue uphill until the junction.

7) When you reach the next junction take the left towards Sugar Loaf Vineyard, which is signposted. Go past the entrance to the vineyard (which will be on your right) and continue climbing uphill on the lane.

8) At the top of the hill, you will cross the cattle grid and shortly afterwards need to continue going upwards on the lane by going around quite a sharp left corner.

9) At the next fork in the road follow signs for the car park or any National Trust symbols that are displayed by the road. Stay on the lane until you reach the car park at the end of the lane where we will be waiting!
